WHAT IS TRIO UPWARD BOUND?

The Anoka-Ramsey Community College Upward Bound Program is a federally funded college readiness program designed to assist students who have the ability and desire to go on to college after they graduate high school. The Upward Bound Program serves as a supplement to the high school experience. The mission of the program is to help students develop the skills and motivation necessary to succeed in education in high school and beyond. All Upward Bound program activities and services are **free** to students enrolled in the program and participants are **not required** to attend Anoka-Ramsey Community college after graduation.

WHO QUALIFIES FOR THE PROGRAM?

To qualify for the program you must meet all of the following criteria:

- 1. Be a student at one of these Independent School District high schools:
 - Braham
 - Cambridge-Isanti
 - Mora

- North Branch
- Princeton
- St. Francis
- 2. Be a potential first-generation college student (custodial parent[s] have not received a four-year college degree) and/or have limited family income
- Be motivated to go to college after graduating from high school
- 4. Be a United States citizen or Permanent Resident

WHAT DO YOU DO IN UPWARD BOUND?

The Upward Bound program consists of three components—after-school tutoring, Saturday sessions, and a six-week summer program. Once admitted, students remain in the program until graduation. Students are not required to re-apply annually.

During the school year, students receive academic instruction, tutoring, advising, and other services twice a week at their high schools. Students work closely with Upward Bound advisors and tutors to track grades and complete homework.

Saturday sessions are held throughout the academic year. Students receive assistance with high school graduation requirements and college entrance exam preparation, academic plans, applications for college, financial aid, scholarships and more. Cultural and social activities, as well as campus visits, are also included in the Saturday sessions.

During the summer, students participate in a six-week summer enhancement program on the Cambridge Campus of Anoka-Ramsey Community College. Activities include academic classes in Math, Science, English, Foreign language; cultural or social events; and campus visits.

- A copy of most recent federal tax form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ (first two pages only). If you did not file taxes, include Social Security and/or unemployment forms.

Next Steps: Applying does not guarantee admission into the program. Completed applications are reviewed by Upward Bound staff. The top candidates are selected for an intake interview with student and parent. After all intake interviews are completed, students are selected for admission into the program.
