



Anoka-Ramsey Community College to Concordia University: BA in Psychology

Students that wish to pursue a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology through Concordia University, St. Paul should complete the following courses at Anoka-Ramsey Community College as part of their Associate of Arts (AA) degree or Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC). Concordia University's degree in Psychology can be completed on the Coon Rapids and Cambridge campuses, or online. Students are able to complete 88 college-level credits through Anoka-Ramsey, and the remaining 32 credits are completed through Concordia University.

Courses to be completed at Anoka-Ramsey Community College as part of the AA degree/MnTC that meet Concordia University's Psychology program requirements:

*A grade of a C or higher is needed for all of the above coursework.

*In order to graduate with a bachelor's degree, a 2.0 GPA in all major-related coursework is needed. *A minimum of 30 credits overall and 50% of major credits must be earned through Concordia University, St. Paul.
