Step 1:

Step 5:

Sign and submit all 3 pages to the address listed on Application

Important deadlines for the Fall 2019 application cycle:

February 1 – applications due

March 15 – ARCC will mail accept, alternate or deny notification letters

April 1 – accept or alternate response forms due





APPLICATION CHECKLIST FOR ANOKA-RAMSEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE (ARCC) NURSING PROGRAM

CHECK OFF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA AND SUBMIT THIS CHECKLIST WITH APPLICATION

Applicants MUST meet all of the following criteria before applying for admission to the nursing program or their application will be denied.

I have reviewed and am aware that I am responsible for all information provided under "Important Links" on RCC's Nursing webpage, in particular the Online Nursing Information Session and Nursing Information Packet at http://www.anokaramsey.edu/nursing

Applicants must apply and be accepted to ARCC before submitting a nursing application. You must list your ARCC student ID number on your application.

Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 must be achieved on the first semester courses as listed on the application and on ARCC's MANE BSN curriculum plan. I am aware that in-progress first semester courses will not be considered in my application evaluation.

All applicants are required to have taken the most current Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI), standardized Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) prior to the application deadlines. Take the TEAS at a MANE school or you will need to request to have the transcript sent to ARCC by calling 1-800-667-7531. You must submit the first page of the Student Individual Performance Profile with the application. A minimum score of 58.7 is required for application to the nursing program.

Applicants licensed as a Practical Nurse (LPN) must provide license number and expiration date on the application. LPN advanced standing is offered fall semester at the Coon Rapids campus only.

All non-Minnesota State (formerly MnSCU) final and official transcripts must be attached to the application sealed and unopened, unless previously submitted to ARCC. Applications will not be processed if required transcripts are not received by the end of the application cycle.

Academic Petitions must be filed at least 2 weeks prior to the application deadline.

We strongly recommend that you meet with an <u>ARCC Academic Advisor</u> (763-433-1230) if you have questions regarding your generaleducation credits. Academic Advisors will not review entire nursing applications prior to submission, but can answer specific questions regarding the application.

Applications will be accepted from December 1 to February 1 for fall admission and April 1 to June 1 for spring admission. You may either drop off the application in a sealed envelope at the designated Nursing Admissions mailbox located in the nursing area on either the Cambridge or Coon Rapids campus or mail to:

The Minnesota Alliance for Nursing Education (MANE) is comprised of member community colleges and Metropolitan State University who collaboratively offer a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree, with dual admittance to Anoka-Ramsey Community College (ARCC) and Metropolitan State University for degree completion. You must be an admitted student to ARCC before submitting this application, which provides the information necessary to be considered for admission to the MANE nursing program.

The application deadline for the Fall 2019 cohort is February 1, 2019. Applicants who are licensed as a Practical Nurse (LPN) with Advanced Standing may be offered admission in the Fall semester only at the Coon Rapids campus. Applicants are required to review information provided in the Online Nursing Information Session and the Nursing Information Packet on ARCC's Nursing webpage at http://www.anokaramsey.edu/nursing.
