

There is a difference between IA (Inclusive Access) within D2L Brightspace and the Digital RedShelf eBook.

Instructors need to setup the IA courses in D2L and it is called a RedShelf Link. The Digital RedShelf eBook is an access code that the student will receive and create their own RedShelf account to access their eBook they purchased from the bookstore.

Please see the following directions on accessing e-materials:

How students access their Digital RedShelf eBook titles:

-Students log in to their Bookstore online accounts (not D2L). The same place you ordered your books online from the bookstore.

-At the top, there will be a link- Activate and Access eBooks. (There will also be a link Click Here to Activate In-Store Purchase- this is **NOT** the one they should be clicking on.) If they have to select a provider, it's going to be RedShelf.

-Under Activate and Access eBooks, students hover over the book and there'll be a button that says "Access" or they can click on the book itself, and that will take them to "Start Reading."

-Students may see a box that says, "This Image Not Available." They can click on this box and should see 'Access' and/or 'Start Reading'.

-If a student doesn't see anything after clicking on Activate and Access eBooks, they may need to scroll all the way down, down the page until they see either the book, a link, or the 'Image Not Available' box.

- The activation e-mail the student receives contain contact information for technical assistance.
