






YOU ARE THE REASON

Program highlights for the year include the MN State Arts Board Grant with creating a beautiful community art mural, generous scholarship donors, and obtaining state-of-the-art equipment in both the Undergraduate Research Studies and Nursing program. We are committed to cultivating an inclusive environment for our students and closing equity gaps between students of color and white students. Our equity work is an essential part of our strategic plan through goals for student success and practices in equity and inclusion.
