Complete the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC)

The B.S. degree at CSS includes general education requirements referred to as Veritas. The College of St. Scholastica accepts the MnTC or AA degree (with MnTC) to fulfill all of the Veritas requirements except for one religious studies course and one upper division Integrations course. The Integrations requirement will be met by EDU 3100 in the major.
