- All nursing courses (NURS) in each semester must be completed with a C or higher to progress to the next semester.
- General education courses can be taken earlier, but not later, than the identified semester.
- Writing in Your Major (WRIT 331) and Upper Division Gen Ed courses cannot be taken at ARCC

- Credits in Associates: 35 Nursing + 40 General Education = 75 Total
- Credits after licensure eligibility: 30 Nursing + 15 General Education (10 of the 15 must be upper division) = 45 Total
- Total Program Credits: 65 Nursing + 55 General Education = 120 Total
