

ANOKA-RAMSEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Anoka-Ramsey Community College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Common Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above*. Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU common curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 48 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

This guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. It is not to be used as an official document in the transfer of courses. CSB/SJU reserve the right to make updates or changes to these guidelines at any time. NOTE: The College of Saint Benedict/Saint John's University are currently implementing an innovative new general education curriculum titled Integrations Curriculum. The new Integrations Curriculum will be in effect for students entering fall 2020 and after. The details of how transfer coursework will apply to specific requirements in the new curriculum is still under development. At this time, we will review transfer coursework in terms of fulfilling elective credits required to earn a bachelor's degree at CSB/SJU.

FIRST YEAR SEMINAR

All incoming first-year students will need to take FYS 100/101 at CSB/SJU. Transfer students may complete this requirement with ENGL 1120 & 1121

HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits per course.

One lab course with a minimum of three semester credits.

SOCIAL SCIENCES

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement. Students majoring in a social science cannot use an introductory course to satisfy this requirement.

Transfer Guide for Anoka-Ramsey Community College

This guide provides information on courses that fulfill specific requirements in the Integrations Curriculum at the College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU). Certain components of our Integrations Curriculum must be completed at CSB/SJU and cannot be completed with transfer coursework.

Integrations Curriculum

The Integrations Curriculum allows students to make connections between your academic coursework, your campus life experiences and your own life and the world around you. Integrated learning—the ability to see relationships among the arts, the sciences, and the humanities—is a valuable, real-life skill that makes CSB/SJU graduates highly sought after by employers and the nation's top graduate programs. You will get an education that builds on the skills and experiences you bring with you to CSB/SJU while exposing you to new topics, new perspectives, and career possibilities you may not even know exist. You'll have a top-tier academic experience and be prepared for a rapidly changing world.

Transfer Credit Evaluation Policies

The evaluation of transfer credits is completed by the Registrar's Office and is based on a student's official transcript(s). Transferable courses are defined as courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above. The Registrar's Office evaluates coursework for credit and applicability towards CSB/SJU's Integrations Curriculum requirements. Academic departments are responsible for evaluating the applicability of coursework toward a student's major or minor. **Note:** A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU integrations curriculum requirement.

Completion of the MnTC or AA Degree

Completion of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) or of an Associate of Arts degree (AA) from a regionally accredited institution will satisfy our foundational integrations curriculum courses. There are additional integrations curriculum requirements that remain to be completed, many that are often attached to other general education or major/minor courses.

Credit and Residency Requirements

All students are required to complete at least 124 semester credits to reach the graduation minimum. Students must complete at least 48 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree at CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.
