

NURSING CURRICULUM PLAN for LPNs – Fall 2024

- All general education courses required in the program and nursing courses (NURS) in each semester must be completed with a C or higher grade to progress to the next semester.
- General education courses can be taken earlier, but not later, than the identified semester.
- This is a Dual Admission Program (DAP) with Metropolitan State University (Metro) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (MSUM). Upper Division Nursing or Gen Ed courses cannot be taken at ARCC

- Credits in Associates: 4 Advanced Standing + 30 Nursing + 30 General Education = 64 Total
- Credits after licensure eligibility = 56 Total (includes upper division credits)
- Total Program Credits: Nursing + General Education = 120 Total
