Required at time of application for admission to the program:

 Proof of a current or expired CNA (Certified Nursing Assistant) is required at the time of application. The certificate number (current or expired) must be listed on the nursing application. LPNs are not required to have CNA certification.
*Nursing Program Exception Requests for CNA substitutions for other trainings or certifications will be considered only if additional training and education documentation is provided.

 Applicants must have already taken the TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) Version 7 test with a minimum score of 58.7. The highest TEAS 7 score will be accepted. A copy of TEAS transcript must be uploaded with the nursing application. Please note this is the last application cycle TEAS is required; subsequent application cycles will require the HSRT test.
