Ceremony Timeline

Time	Activity
6:00 PM	Graduate check-in and receive name card in the Field House (G118)
6:00 PM	Doors open for guest seating in the Performance Gym (G100)
6:30 PM	Graduates line up in alphabetical/numerical order according to the number written on your name card in the Field House (G118)
7:00 PM	Processional/Ceremony begins in the Performance Gym (G100)
8:15 PM	Ceremony concludes

Ceremony Instructions for Graduates

We encourage you to leave personal belongings at home or with your family/guests as there will be no secure location for you to store them during the ceremony.

1. Check-in at the ARCC Fieldhouse at 6:00 PM. You will receive a name card (don't lose this) and honor/veteran/TRIO cords if applicable.
2. Graduates are required to wear graduation regalia.
3. The ceremony begins with the processional march led by faculty members. Graduates walk from the Field House to the Performance Gym and will be seated.
4. The conferring of degrees will begin after the welcome, introductions, and speeches.
5. Graduates will be invited to come forward to receive diploma covers (*diplomas mailed later*).

6. At the direction of a faculty member, graduates are to rise together by row and approach the right side of the stage. A ramp is available adjacent to the stage.
7. As you approach the announcer, hand your name card to them.
8. As your name is announced, begin your walk across the stage.
9. Receive your diploma with your left hand; shake the President's hand with your right hand. If you wish not to shake hands, please keep your hands at your side. **Please do not move your tassel at this point.**
10. Return to your chair and remain standing until everyone in the row is back; sit down together.
11. When all rows have received their diplomas, the president will tell all graduates to stand and **use your right hand to move the tassel from the right side of your cap to the left side of your cap.** He will then congratulate the class of 2025.
12. After all diplomas have been presented, the president, dignitaries, and faculty will lead the recessional. Graduates will all stand, and a faculty member will release one row at a time.
13. Please do not wait for family members in the hallway outside of the gym.
14. Dismissal of family members will begin once the graduates have left the Performance Gym.
