Scholarship Award

One Scholarship Award of \$1,500

Applicant Eligibility

Candidate must:

- Willing to volunteer for a minimum of 40 hours of volunteer service in one or more of the Tusen Tack Programs.
- Candidate must have maintained a log of volunteer service dates, hours and activity; the tracking log to be submitted with the completed scholarship application.
- Enrolled at Pine Technical Community College Pine City, MN or Anoka- Ramsey community College in a two year or four-year program.
- Must have a minimum (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.

Award Selection Process

The Tusen Tack Scholarship Committee will review and consider only complete applications.

Applications will be rated on the following criteria:

- Volunteer service to the Tusen Tack organization (including quality, hours and extent of service)
- Quality or overall presentation of application
- Personal and professional goals
- Completion of all required essay questions

Requirement(s) for disbursement of Scholarship Award

- All-award recipient must provide the following documentation prior to disbursement of funds:
- Proof of enrollment at Pine Technical Community College Pine City, MN or Anoka-Ramsey Community College, Cambridge Campus in a two year or four-year program.
- A photocopy of the recipient's first or second semester transcript indicating satisfactory grades. (GPA) of 2.5 or higher
- Documents need to be submitted to Tusen Tack Programs at the Braham Event Center
- Upon meeting the above requirements, the scholarship award will be issued to assist with the costs of tuition and fees required for enrollment or attendance or for course-related expenses, such as fees, text books, supplies, equipment, campus housing and campus food.
