

Creating a free Learning Express Library account

From our library homepage (<http://www.anokaramsey.edu/resources/library/>), scroll down and click on the bar labeled Scholarly Journals and Newspaper Databases.

Click on the link that says Learning Express Library, and look for the Sign In/Register link in the blue bar near the top of the page. That will take you to a registration form like this image. If you do not see the New User Registration page, contact a librarian for assistance.
